Albert Charles Marvin Bellevue born Easter Sunday in the little village of Milneburg (New Orleans) April 20, 1919 passed away on July 10, 2013 at the age of 94. He resided in New Orleans for 23 years, and was a resident of Metairie since 1950. Albert had many accomplishments, which included graduating from Samuel J. Peters High School in New Orleans. He served as a Technical Sergeant in the Army Ground Forces in Washington D.C. during WWII. He began his art career from graduating at the American Academy of Art in Chicago, IL and became an advertising and fine artist at several firms.
