



Alice Mary Muhleisen Poissenot

June 21, 1918 - March 19, 2012

Alice Mary Muhleisen Poissenot, a retired secondary school teacher, received Our Lord in the Sacrament of Communion at the annual Sacred Heart homecoming mass on Sunday, March 18 and the Lord received Alice on Monday, March 19 when she passed away peacefully in the presence of her family at East Jefferson General Hospital. She was 93, a native of New Orleans and a resident of Jefferson Parish for the past 63 years. Alice graduated from Sacred Heart of Jesus High School and Ursuline College. She taught second grade at St. Catherine of Siena (1949-1955), English and Social Studies at Metairie High School (1955-1966) and Riverdale High School (1966-1970) and was librarian at Bissenot Plaza Elementary School (1970-1980). She was a member of St. Philip Neri Young at Heart, the Palm Vista Garden Club, Sacred Heart Alumni and Ursuline Alumnae Associations. Beloved wife of the late Paul Alfred Poissenot. Mother of Nanette P. Barnett and the late Paul A. Poissenot, Jr. D.D.S. (Lynne). Grandmother of Brady Michael Barnett (Dawn), Lisa R., Paul A., III (Mary), and Michael E. Poissenot (Lulu). Great-grandmother of Christopher M. and Brandon D. Barnett and Nicole Lynne, Rachael and Jeremy Poissenot. Daughter of the late Isabella Bellott and Adam Arthur Muhleisen. Sister of the late Louis A., Adam A., Jr., Paul A. and Infant Elizabeth Muhleisen. Also survived by nieces and nephews.
