



Alonso Andara, Sr.

December 30, 1930 - October 23, 2021

On October 23, 2021, Alonso Andara Sr. passed away peacefully in his home. He was born in Puerto Cortes, Honduras and was 91 years old. His life was one full of experiences.

Alonso came to America in 1952, with nothing but a dream for a better life and his business ambition. He served in the U.S. Army from 1954-55, travelling the world, and eventually – and proudly – becoming a U.S. citizen in 1955. He was one of the first Hispanics to obtain a freight forwarding license after he purchased and began operating Magnolia Forwarding Company, Inc. in 1960. Alonso transformed Magnolia into a thriving family business where his wife and children have worked. Magnolia was Alonso's passion – he showed up every day for 61 years. He was a titan to his family and those who knew him, but he was also a man of character and generosity. While he never liked to admit it, he often helped out those around him without expecting anything in return.

Even in old age, Alonso was a young spirit. He could recount his life stories with vivid detail, whether he was discussing his time on the ships in Vietnam, Panama, and Europe or his two-week stay in Argentina for the FIFA World Cup in 1978, all while wearing his fitted teal colored blazer.

Alonso leaves behind his wife of 59 years, Carmen Andara and their three children Alonso Jr. (wife: Zinnia), Maria (husband: Allan), Frank (wife: Colleen); his grandchildren; Alonso III, Alexander (deceased), Alexandria, Anthony, Mackenzie, Kennedy, and Hannah; his brothers, Gustavo and

Salomon (deceased); his family member, Alcira; and many other loved ones too numerous to name.

Goodbye, Alonso. We know you are watching over us from a better place.

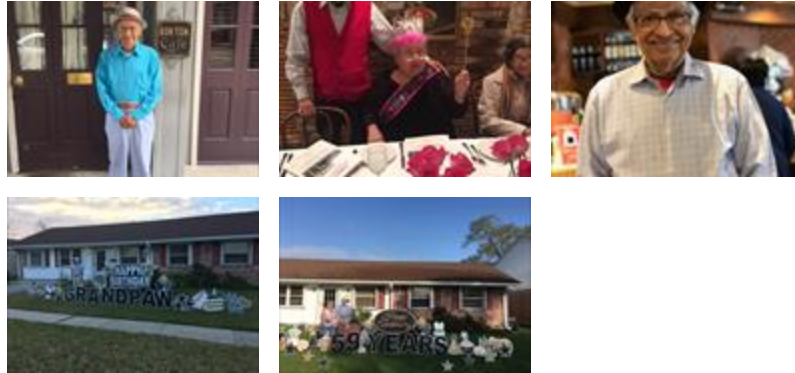
