Anthony Damian Hartigan, born in Kenton, Middlesex, England March 5th 1934, passed away at East Jefferson General Hospital on Monday, October 7th, 2013 from complications due to pneumonia at the age of 79. He was a resident of New Orleans and Kenner for the last forty-seven years.

He served five years in the British Royal Air Force - Air-Sea Rescue, studied six years with the Divine Word Missionary order in Wales, Ireland and Illinois. He taught High School English for the Brothers of the Sacred Heart at Cor Jesu, Aloysius and Brother Martin High Schools for thirty-six years. He was also an English and Gifted and Talented teacher at Jefferson Parish schools: West Jefferson, Grace King and Higgins and retired in 2005.
