On February 16, 2024, God sent his angels to usher Reverend Arthur Brown's spirit home to be with his heavenly father.

Reverend Arthur Brown was born on Oct 2, 1934, to the late James Brown, Sr. and Stella Joseph Brown in Ama, LA. He was the youngest of 15 children.

At an early age, Rev. Brown accepted Christ as his personal savior and was baptized at Providence Baptist Church in Kenner, LA. He became a member of the Sunbeam Assembly #5 and was a faithful singer with gospel groups.

Rev. Brown was educated in the public school of Jefferson Parish. He graduated and decided to join the U.S. Army. He served in the NATO Europe 2nd Armored Division, ranked as a Sergeant.

Rev. Brown was called to the ministry. He received his minister license from the Church of God in Christ under the leadership of Bishop J. A. Blakes on October 3, 1982.

To be well equipped to impart God's word, he attended United Theological Seminary and Bible College and received a Master of

Theology Degree on May 23, 1992. He became an ordained minister at Peaceful Rest Baptist Church in Aurora, Colorado on December 31, 1994.

After relocating back home in Kenner, he united with Hill of Zion Baptist Church under the leadership of the Rev. Allen Creecy. After his demise, he served under the leadership of Rev. Dr. Eric Dixon. Rev. Brown loved leading bible study at Westminster Tower.
