It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Dr. Brian Richard O'Callaghan, PhD, on Wednesday, March 2, 2022. Dr. O'Callaghan was born on October 9, 1944.

Dr. O'Callaghan began his educational journey at St. Anthony of Padua elementary school, then proceeded to Jesuit High School. He graduated from Loyola University with a B.S. degree, Florida State University with a Masters degree, and Louisiana State University with a doctorate in mathematics. He spent many years teaching at Metairie Park Country Day School and at Southeastern Louisiana University.

Dr. O'Callaghan was devoted to his West Highland White Terriers, for all of his adult life, having raised many Grand Champions. His pups were the light of his life.

He was the companion of the late Mark Avery Smith, son of the late Richard William O'Callaghan and Jean Erichson O'Callaghan, brother of Sandra O.
