“ I was stunned to tears when I heard the news of my dear friend Charles Lee. I have known him since we were teenagers. Our families before and after we were married are deeply entwined.

Although he was ill for some time he never complained. Each time I would meet him and ask how he was doing his standard response was, “good”. He was a tough guy and never imposed on anyone to pity him.

We shared many adventures together. As kids we fought together on the streets. When I was drafted and deployed to Vietnam as an Army Combat Infantryman in 1966 Charles reenlisted because he said he wanted to be with me. He had already served three years previously. There was no “buddy plan” for us then. Although we were serving at the same time we never did see each other but we wrote when time allowed. In those days we communicated by letter, but the soggy correspondence that took a minimum of two weeks to reach us were treasured. In 1970 I became a Kenner Police Officer. Charlie joined me there shortly thereafter. And we were off on another great adventure. When I became Chief of Police in 1990 Charles was my constant companion as we traveled to every town in the state to meet other Police Chiefs.

Charlie had an infectious and inviting smile that naturally drew everyone to him. He was ever faithful to his wife, his family and his friends. He had no enemies and never degraded anyone. He was an exceptional man and dear friend.

This world is a little dimmer now that my friend is not here. Charlie, I pray I do see you again for one more great adventure.
