



Clebert "Sonny" Guidry

August 19, 1920 - June 3, 2014

Clebert 'Sonny' Guidry passed away peacefully on June 3, 2014 at the age of 93. Sonny was a master welder in the Boilermaker Local Union #37, a proprietor of local grocery stores in the city of New Orleans, and a master storyteller of life's adventures and lessons. He was an avid fisherman and hunter. He served in the U.S. Army as Sergeant in Company C 394th Military Police Battalion from 1944 to 1946.

He married Ethel Dubroc on December 7, 1941. He is preceded in death by his loving wife of 67 years, Ethel Dubroc Guidry, who went to meet the Lord in January 2008. He is survived by his six daughters: Linda Guidry Gagnard (Alvin), Sharon Guidry Fabregas (Clarence), Faye Guidry McLemore (John), Dr. Jessie Guidry Baginski (Thom), Wanda Guidry Salzer (Brian), and Suzanne Guidry Perez (Joseph). He and his wife, Ethel, spent many hours at the family camp in Pointe au Chien fishing and entertaining their daughters, sons-in-law and 15 grandchildren. He enjoyed the company of his 17 great-grandchildren and 1 great-great-grandchild. He is also survived by his loving canine companion, Rotney.
