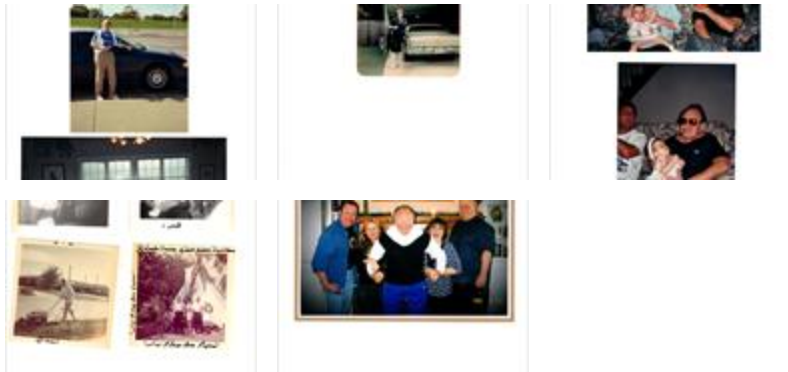
“ To Danny and Family,
