St. Charles Parish Deputy Sheriff Jeff G. Watson died in the line of duty on Sunday, August 4, 2013. He was 41, a native of Metairie and a resident of Destrehan for the past 8 years. He graduated from Loyola College Prep in Shreveport and was a deputy for the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office prior to moving to St. Charles Parish in 2005. Beloved husband of Lynsey Parker Watson. Stepfather of Abrial Suarez. Son of Becky Cummings Watson, Harry W. Watson and James F. Byl. Brother of Christie W. Rivet, Rachel W. Cook and Nikki Hendrick. Nephew of Jodi Cummings, retired detective sergeant of JPSO.

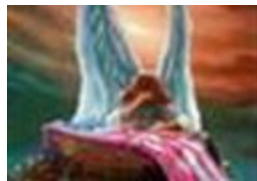

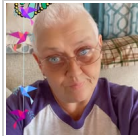
