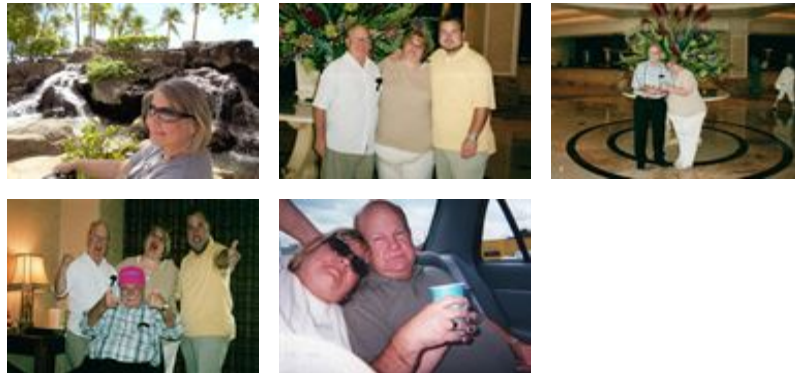
I remember as a young child, us sitting in your living room as the adults watched Lawrence Welk, and you and I plucking your Dads leg hair.

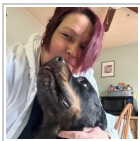
