Doris McKay Jackson passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 24, 2021 at the age of 86 due to complications of ovarian cancer. She was a native of New Orleans, LA and a resident of Kenner, LA.

She is preceded in death by her husband Frank Joseph Jackson, Jr. and her parents Mary Carlean Bahan McKay and Earl Lester McKay, Sr.

Over the years, she was a member and volunteered at Bridgedale Baptist Church, First Baptist Church Kenner, and Williams Boulevard Baptist Church, where she was an interpreter for the hearing impaired, taught Sunday school and volunteered in the Special Ministry department.

She retired from the Jefferson Parish School System after 20 years as a

paraprofessional. She worked with the hearing impaired at Hilda Knoff School for the Deaf, Hazel Park Elementary School, and Bissonet Elementary. She also worked in the Community Education Department, Before and After school programs, and was the director of summer camps for several years in the 80's and 90's throughout Jefferson Parish.

Doris and her husband enjoyed sailing on their boat. At the age of 80, she got her first tattoo, a sailboat, as a remembrance of her late husband and her love of sailing with him.
