Edward Emmett 'Ed' Madden, Jr. passed away peacefully at his residence in the presence of his family on Tuesday, April 23, 2013. He was 77, a native of Boston, MA and a resident of Metairie for over 50 years. He graduated from Massachusetts College of Pharmacy, entered the United States Public Health Service from which he retired as a Captain after 22 years. He earned an MBA from Loyola University and a Doctorate in Public Health from Tulane University. After retirement, his career continued in Managed Care and Pharmacy in the Metropolitan New Orleans area. He was an adjunct Professor at Tulane University where he taught the first Managed Care courses. He also taught at Xavier University School of Pharmacy. He was an active parishioner and Eucharistic Minister at St. Philip Neri, where he taught RCIA for many years. Ed was also a proud member of the Serra Club.
