Elda Ann Gremillion Ducote, a gracious and devoted wife and mother passed away at home with her family by her side on Friday, August 26, 2016. She was 81, born at home in Plaucheville, LA and a resident of Harahan for the past 63 years. Preceded in death by her husband of 50 years, Ned E.
