George Peter Robbins, III passed away at his home in New Orleans on Tuesday, April 7, 2015. Native and lifelong resident of New Orleans, age 74 years. Beloved husband of 24 years of Patricia C. Lifetime member of the IEEE and ISA organizations, president of the local chapter of The National Electrical Manufacturers Association as well as having served on the National Board then as Regional Vice President of NEMR. Peter was a longtime member of many carnival organizations, most

notably with REX/School of Design. Peter was a true gourmand and wine enthusiast; one of his great passions in life was traveling with his wife Patricia, most often to visit the great wine producing regions of Europe and California.
