



Harold P. Noonan Jr.

December 18, 1943 - April 5, 2019

Harold P. Noonan, Jr., a New Orleans native, and longtime resident of Metairie, LA died at his home at the age of 75 surrounded by his family on Friday, April 5, 2019 after a 9 month battle with cancer, but he ultimately died from a broken heart one week after losing his beloved wife of nearly 56 years. He was the devoted father of three sons and one daughter, H. Patrick Noonan, III (Sherry), Kevin P. Noonan, Robert A. Noonan, and Alicia N. Ancar (Cory), as well as, the proud grandfather of Connor Noonan, Claire Noonan, Ava Ancar, Camron Ancar, Chloe Ancar and Devin Martinsen.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Stenie Avenel Noonan, his mother, Ola Mae Phelps Noonan, and his father, Harold P. Noonan.

He met his sweetheart shortly after joining the Army and married her while on leave in 1963. He owned and operated the Aamco Transmission on Hickory Avenue for many years before going to work as an insurance agent until he retired. 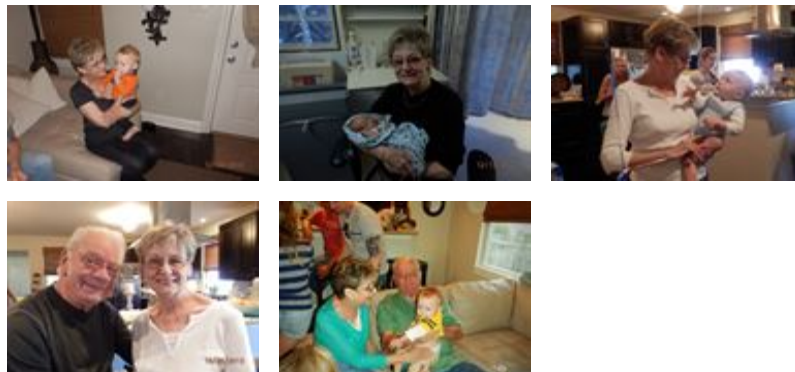

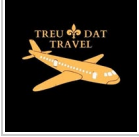
