The family of Jody Conrad Rome sadly announces their loss at the age of 63, on Saturday, February 11, 2023 after a valiant battle with cancer. Jody was welcomed into God's Grace and at last, reunited with his father Francis "Frank" George Rome and mother Sally Ann Madere Rome and recently preceded in death by his sister Wendy Townsend.

Jody was a faithful, loving husband and was the adored spouse of Deeni Robin Rome, whom he so often called "baby doll", "love of my life" and "my bride and joy". Beloved father of Brandon Rome (Laurie), Matthew "Matt" Rome, Victoria Rome Lott (John) and Jim Shannon (Crissy). Jody is survived by his sisters Claudia Carter (Jack) and Ginger Rockweiler (Steven). Jody was the beloved grandfather "Pa J" to Tylor and Amber. Jody was Parran to Joshua Carter (Gillian), Chad Granier, Eric Rockweiler (Whitney) and Melissa Lacoste. Jody had several great nieces and nephews in addition to many friends that he cherished as "extended family".

Jody was a native of New Orleans until his family established residency in Metairie in 1970. Later in his adult life he would establish permanent roots in Kenner for the remainder of his life.

Jody attended Holy Cross High School and was a member of the Scouts, ranking Eagle Scout in 1976. After graduation, he immediately started employment with a bank institution while performing live music at night.

Jody was an educated, inventive and driven man, as demonstrated with his return to college in his later years and by achieving his goal in obtaining a degree in business at the University of New Orleans, graduating Summa Cum Laude and top ten in his class.

Excelling in management, with a specialty in finance and project management, Jody earned the title of Executive Director in one of the country's oldest cemetery organizations, also including those leadership roles in security, safety and construction operations management.

Jody's persona had a kindle feeling of "joie de vivre" and was larger than life. All that were fortunate to come in contact with him became part of his family. His laughter, love, interest and care of everyone was radiant; his religious faith was contagious. He loved to see people smile, he enjoyed this through his music, entertainment and weekly gatherings. This was evident at an early age that started in the Tiger School Band and was carried with him through his life as an accomplished pianist, vocalist and entertainer in his professional bands named Sunshine, The T-Birds, Gold Fever, Rock Outs, American Graffiti and Dual Exhaust. He later established himself in the karaoke business where he remained for 27 years and gained numerous "cherished" friendships until the end.

Not only did the love of music run through Jody's veins, so did Black n Gold. Jody loved sports, two specifically...league bowling with his family and football, specifically the New Orleans Saints. Saints football with the family and friends at his residence was a seasonal, highlighted event. So much so that their residence was named the "Rome Dome" where ticket prices were paid with
