John Ellis passed away on Sunday, August 18, 2013 at the age of 64. He was a native of Long Island, NY and a resident of Covington, LA. He attended Westminster College and upon graduation taught at Portledge School until he was recruited by St. Martin's Episcopal School in Metairie. He completed 44 years in education as head of the science department at East St. John High School, where he was able to bring Russian Cosmonauts and Charles Bolden, the current director of NASA, to the school to speak to the student body. John loved space and space travel, enjoyed meeting astronauts and attending shuttle launches. He watched John Glenn return to space and organized a student trip to watch the last launch of the Challenger. He loved camping at Camp Adirondack in northern New York State, where he served as a counselor for many years. John developed and performed the "Fun With Science" show for DuPont at local and national conferences.
