John David Mayeux passed away on Saturday, April 2, 2022 at the age of 86. He was born on September 5, 1935, in Plaquemine, LA and was a resident of New Orleans, LA and Kenner, LA.

John graduated from St. Joseph Academy in 1953 (under duress) accepting the general scholarship award. Then, in 1956, he was awarded a Bachelor of Arts degree at Southwestern Louisiana Institute of Lafayette with a 2.80 GPA. Applying for a job as a Commercial Artist proved to be futile with no experience. Accepting employment as a Draftsman, he evolved into Design-Draftsman, spanning the fields of architecture, metal works, offshore oil platforms, refineries, reinspections of a nuclear plant, a wastewater plant operator, abandoned building monitor, a plan reviewer, developer of standards and office forms.

He was preceded in death by a brother, John Evans Mayeux (1932), his father P. Clinton (1968), his mother Eunice Saucier (1975), his sister Vida Rose (1995) and by her husband Johnnie L. Ducote (1986), by his spouse Joyce T. Cunningham (1998), and by a number of aunts, uncles and relatives.
