John Anthony Voigt, Jr. passed away on December 11, 2023, while in hospice care at home with his family. Born in New Orleans, Louisiana on January 23, 1931, he is survived by wife Margaret; daughter Patricia; grandchildren Alexander, Steven, Nathan, Brendan, Brian, and Riely; great-grandchildren Julia and Bentley; nieces Sharyn, Anita, and Colleen; and numerous grand and great-grand nieces and nephews. A lifelong resident of New Orleans, John attended St. Aloysius High School, joined the Air National Guard, and for a time served in the Christian Brothers. John loved his native city and enjoyed walking through the French Quarter, eating local seafood, listening to music, looking at old New Orleans houses, cheering for the Saints, and visiting local Christmas light displays. His greatest joy though was in his grandchildren, and some of his happiest and proudest hours were spent taking them to sports activities or to the Zoo or Aquarium.
