Joseph Ralph Millet died on Sunday, March 15, 2015. He was 91, a native of Reserve, a resident of Metairie for 60 years, and a resident of the Southeast Louisiana War Veterans Home for the past 4 years. Beloved husband of the late Rowena Robert Millet. Father of J. Ralph Millet, Jr., MD (Elaine) and Richard C. Millet (Paulette). Son of the late Marie Claire Jacob Millet and Joseph Marcilien Millet. Mr. Millet proudly served our country during WWII in the U.S. Coast Guard on the USS Machias (PF-53). He was a life member of VFW Post 5004, Reserve, LA and a member of the American Legion, Robert H. Burns Post 16 in Covington. He was employed in the Cardiology Department of Tulane Medical Center from 1945 through 1985. There, as a member of the cardiovascular research team of Dr. George E. Burch, M.D., he designed, built and operated research equipment, and participated in various research studies. He was one of the founders of Boy Scout Troop 117 at St. Christopher Church and School and was the first scoutmaster. During his residency at the Southeast Louisiana War Veterans Home he developed a deep interest in art and painting which brought joy to many people.
