Katherine Magner, R.N. went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, August 10, 2014. She was born on March 3, 1941 in New Orleans, LA. She lived in Baton Rouge graduating from Baton Rouge Senior High in 1959. She worked for Wade O. Martin in the Capital until she enlisted in the U.S. Navy in June 1961 serving until June 1964 during the Viet Nam Conflict. She was stationed with her sister Patricia at Lemoore Naval Air Station as a Medic with the rank of Hospital man 3rd class. During this time of service she and her sister loved helping others, so she entered into Charity Hospital School of Nursing in September 1965 graduating with honors in 1968. She was editor of the White Cap during her senior year. She worked at Ochsner for a few years then went to the newly opened East Jefferson General Hospital in 1971 working in Maternal Child health for 36 years. She was an RNC and had a vast knowledge of Fetal Monitoring. She was instrumental in many of her co-workers obtaining the same standard of excellence retiring from active duty in 2008. She worshiped at Williams Blvd. Baptist Church where Brother Tim Williams will have a home going service. She was the daughter of the late Eleanor McCoy Magner and Robert Edward Magner. She leaves behind her sisters, Patricia A. Magner, R.N., (with whom she lived with), Mildred Magner Pittman (husband, Calvin Earl Pittman) of Gulfport, MS and Sharon Magner Dendy (husband, Jimmy R.
