



## Lloyd Adolph Constans, Jr.

June 13, 1932 - April 25, 2017

On April 25, 2017, at the age of 84, Lloyd Adolph Constans, Jr. was called home to eternal rest. He was surrounded by his family, including his wife of over 60 years, Betty Raziano Constans and his three daughters, Betty Constans Odinet (husband, Keith Odinet), Constance Constans Franzone (husband, Frank Franzone) and Susan Mary Constans. He is survived by his two grandchildren, Christopher Odinet (husband, McHenry Lee, II) and Kyle Odinet (wife, Johlee Schinetsky Odinet). He was preceded in death by his mother, Agnes Amos Constans and his father, Lloyd Adolph Constans, Sr. Lloyd had spent most of his life in the construction materials business, selling concrete, limestone, and trucking. He was also a very talented sharpshooter with pistols and rifles. Lloyd enjoyed horses, woodworking and welding, hunting, and attending and participating in cutting horse competitions. Lloyd was also an extremely knowledgeable horseman and former champion cutting horse rider and champion calf roper – he was a National Cutting Horse judge and an American Quarter Horse judge. Upon learning of his death, one of his friends said, “Lloyd was a real cowboy and was the only real cowboy I have ever known.”
