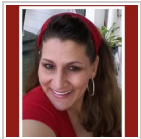

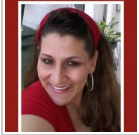


“ Mom,

And in my heart and memories you will always be!

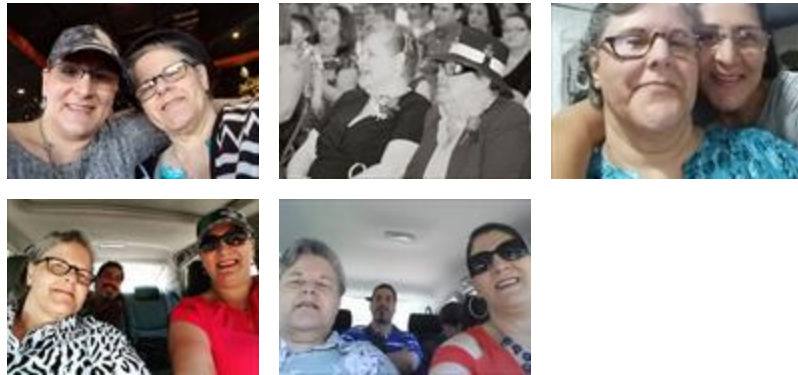
Though I knew I'd never be ready for this day to come

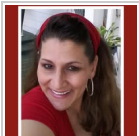
