Lowell Bernard Rodrigue passed away on Saturday, December 18, 2021 at the age of 97. He was a native of Edgard, LA and a resident of River Ridge, LA.

Lowell was a 1941 graduate from Destrehan High School. He attended LSU until he served in the Navy during WW II from 1943 to 1946. Lowell was wounded in the American Campaign in the Peleliu Islands. He was a recipient of the Purple Heart Medal as well as the American Campaign, Asiatic Pacific and WW II Victory Medals and a Unit Citation Ribbon. He was a life long member of the Military Order of the Purple Heart. Lowell retired in January 1985 after 29 years as District Manager of American Greeting Cards. He was a parishioner of St. Matthew the Apostle Catholic Church for 50 years. Lowell enjoyed golf, collecting antique cars, and traveling with "Baby Mae." He was a passionate fan of LSU and the Saints.

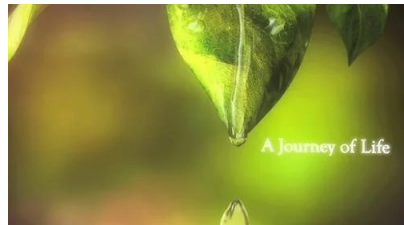

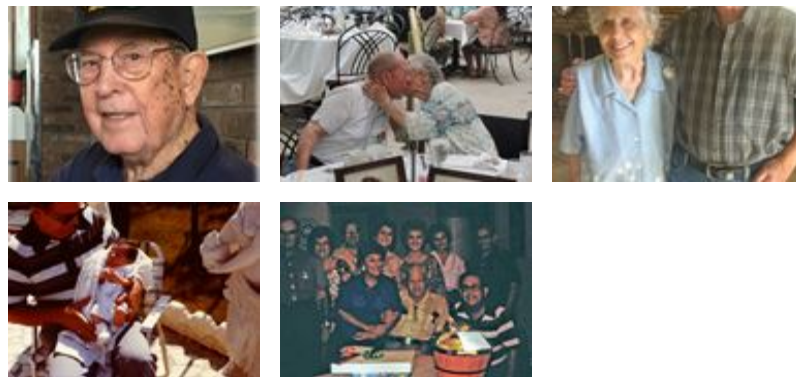
