Lucy Adams Kuylen peacefully passed away on October 7, 2015 in the loving presence of her family at the age of 65. Lucy excelled at nurturing people, plants, and animals. She adored her grandchildren. She was passionate about education and reading. She was revered for cooking the world's best damn seafood gumbo. She was a graduate of Enon High School (Class of 1968) and received a bachelor's degree from Southeastern Louisiana University in Hammond and a master's degree from Southern University in New Orleans. As a social worker, she dedicated her career to advocating for Louisiana's abused and neglected children and improving the conditions of child and residential care facilities. Lucy is survived by her husband, Frederick Kuylen, Jr., her children, Justin Lee Hawks (Elizabeth), Ana Moreno Ott (George), and Christina Moreno Kammer (Noel), and her grandchildren, Alexis Hawks, Austin Hawks, Jackson Ott, Madison Hawks, and Brady Kammer. She is also survived by two sisters, Ola Adams Hobgood and Carolyn Adams McCain, and by two brothers, Clyde Adams (Sue) and Danny Adams (Cindy).
