Mrs. Feng's parents were both Christians. Her near neighbors were also Christians. This neighbor was none other than Li Shi Guang! They were friends for many years, and then they were married in 1956. Mr. Li was also a strong believer in Jesus.

Mrs. Feng's love of God's Word made her a natural for her work, teaching Chinese in the K-12 setting. Her husband was also a teacher. God blessed them with two sons, Repent and Joseph. It seems that their lives were idyllic, but such was not the case. Right after their marriage, Mrs. Feng was struggled against, but she was an innocent person. She was given the

smallest room at her work place. Her husband Mr. Li was sent hundreds of miles away. They suffered from poverty and mockery for years. "Of whom the world was not worthy." However, God gave them grace to maintain their faith. She received a certificate as an evangelist from her church. Mrs. Feng was a woman who made things happen, an active, happy extrovert. She would get on her bicycle and go into an area and preach the Gospel, delivering sermons that Mr. Li had written out, as at that time he was too ill to join her. Her life is a wonderful testimony of God's love. She was frequently heard saying, "Love God. Love other people." and "Let's pray about these matters."

Mr. and Mrs. Li had three grandsons: TianMin in China, and John and James in the U.S. They dearly loved all three. They also cherished many close relatives in China and in the U.S.

Mr. and Mrs. Li moved to the Home of Grace in their later years, where they spent much time in Bible study and prayer. Mrs. Feng would preach with intensity regardless of the number of persons in her audience. She would prepare and search the Scriptures for just the right Word. She would stand and preach fervently to only four people as well as to larger groups. Mrs. Feng preached through all of her later years. For as long as anyone can remember, she loved the Lord Jesus. What a great woman of God! To God be all the glory.
