He attended Destrehan High School before enlisting in the US Army National Guard. Mark later graduated from Southeastern Louisiana University.

Mark was a Medical Lab Specialist E5 with the 159th Mash Unit of the United States Army National Guard in New Orleans, LA. He worked as a Biological Science Technician for the United States Department of Agriculture in New Orleans. He also spent time volunteering for the VA Hospital and other areas in his community.

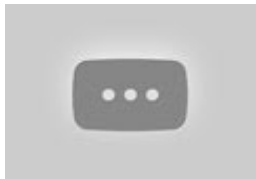
