“ Mitchell was his own man. He believed in hard work and tried to instill this into his son (Lil Mitchell) and his extended family for the last 31 years, Sandy Revere, Shannyn Revere, and Wayne Revere. He adored his grandchildren, especially Aaron (Lil Mitchell's son), and his granddaughter Alexis (daughter of Sandy) and all his grandchildren, too many to count. He was hard and firm. He could be fun and funny but was not a man that wanted this side of him to show very much. He spoke his mind. He left behind the one he loved so passionately until the day of his death, his wife and partner for the last 31 years Debbie Ann Smith Beard. They lived together for all those years (even until several months after his diagnosis of Brain Cancer-she would lay on the floor next to his bed in case he would need anything and was up all times of the day and night with him-even though it hurt him physically he always wanted her laying next to him in the bed just to lay there with his arm around her) and had their ups and downs like any other married couple while raising all their children and as Big Mitchell spoke to me and said, "Debbie is the love of my life till the day I die and beyond that I will always make sure she is taken care of even after I am gone." He was not very talkative but we spoke every chance we got. He was very PROUD of his son (Lil Mitchell). I was blessed to be able to speak to Big Mitchell a few weeks before his death, he said to me, " I love Debbie and Mitchell and I am proud of my son- I hope he is always strong and successful." Debbie, Blanch and I was joking with him and even got him to smile several times even when taking the pictures with Debbie. You could look at him looking at Debbie while giving her a kiss, hugging her and telling her he loved her and tell he adored and loved her passionately. Debbie was able to lay by his side for the little while we had to spend with him. He was coherent and lucid. He looked at Debbie gave her a kiss he kept hugging her as tight as he could (and did not want to let her go) and told her, "I LOVE YOU FOREVER." Mitchell, you were a hard man and believed in hard work, you will be missed very much. Your son (Lil Mitchell is working hard, I have had the pleasure of observing him and he seems to be following in your footsteps of working hard and helping his mother). Your soul mate Debbie, (your son Lil Mitchell

and extended family and grandchildren) is now lost without you. They will love and miss you forever, and so will I! We are all glad you are not suffering anymore and out of pain. No one deserves that. Just know the love of your life (Debbie) and your son (Lil Mitchell) always wanted to spend time with you and be with you to the end of this life on earth but the family dynamics would not allow that to happen, you were and are always in their hearts.
