She also served at St. Lawrence the Martyr, St. Matthew the Apostle, and St. Bonaventure Catholic Churches and Schools. As a consultant for

William H. Sadler Publishing Co. for 35 years, Nancy assisted in the training of Catechists throughout the Southeast. Nancy ministered as the Co-Coordinator of RCIA and the Director of Kids' Catholic Kingdom at St. Albert Catholic Chapel in Hammond. She was the recipient of the Saint Louis Award in the Archdiocese of New Orleans for her outstanding service to the Catholic Church.
