



Patricia "Patsy" Burns Kruebbe

December 30, 1954 - February 7, 2015

Kruebbe, Patricia "Patsy" Burns passed away February 7, 2015 at her residence after a long battle with cancer. She was 60 years old. She was a native of New Orleans, LA and a resident of Destrehan, LA for the past 5 years.

Her parents are the late Charles Joseph Burns and Yvonne Jolls Burns. She is survived by her husband, Barrett "Barry" Kruebbe; her sisters, Carolyn R. Grassel, Jacquelyn R. Bivona, Linda R. Frechou, Yvonne B. Firmin; and brother, Michael C. Ravain, Sr. She was preceded in death by siblings, Eugene J. Ravain, Jr., Joan R. Carrington and Ronald R. Ravain. Also survived by a host of nieces and nephews, with special recognition to her niece, Sherin Firmin.

Patsy was a 1972 graduate of Warren Easton High School in New Orleans and attended Tulane University. She was a longtime employee of the national headquarters of the Volunteers of America where she retired as a minister. She was a lifelong advocate of animals and founded the non-profit organization Support Alliance for Stray Animals (SASA) where she helped hundreds of people adopt stray and abandoned pets she had rescued. After Hurricane Katrina she helped maintain animal control in the Kenner area. She frequently worked with other non-profit organizations such as The Louisiana Humane Society, LASPCA, St. Charles Humane Society, Animal Rescue of New Orleans, and many others dedicated to the goal of helping our four-legged friends. She was also instrumental in abolishing the arbitrary "Four Pet

Limit Law” in the City of Kenner with the help of the Louisiana Humane Society.
