Percy J. Babineaux, Sr., 82, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family in Forest Hill, LA on November 11, 2018. Percy was born January 17, 1936 in Church Point, LA.

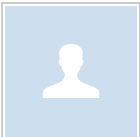
