Robert (Bob) LeBoeuf, age 73, died from cancer at home on July 9, 2022, on his 48th wedding anniversary, with his wife and daughter at his side. Bob was a good and generous man who put his family above all and worked hard to provide for them. He always worried about their happiness, prioritizing it above his own.

Bob was born on August 27, 1948 in Thibodaux, LA and grew up in Cut Off and Schriever, LA. He graduated from Terrebonne High School and Nicholls State University.
