Bobby heard us at one of these performances and decided to make us his backup singers. He took three unexperienced gals and taught us how to sing backup with a band. We then performed with him at Italian-American functions in New Orleans, the 1984 World's Fair in the Italian Pavilion, with Pete Fountain's Band, and many other functions. We also sang backup on an album he produced and starred in. It was the best 3 years of my life and we would have shared those times longer, but one of the gals unfortunately moved away and nobody could take her place. Now that I'm an old lady, I have beautiful memories of those times. Bobby spent countless hours shaping and molding us into the singers he wanted us to be and we had a good rapport with him and his band. He also featured us (usually singing Italian songs) during his shows. Thank you Bobby. May you rest in peace!
