Robert H. Reynolds, known affectionately by all as “Mr. Bob”, passed away on April 10, 2026, in Fort Gibson, Mississippi, at the age of 86, leaving behind a life marked by devotion, hard work, and love for those around him.

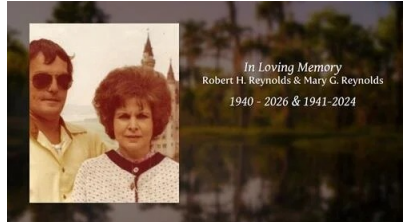
