Sister Angelique served at Mercy Hospitals in Louisiana, Mississippi and Texas and had a long ministry at Mercy Hospital, St. Louis in radiologic technology and health care administration. Since 2009 she ministered in the human resources and mission departments of Mercy Health System. Sister is survived by her brothers, Anthony J.
