On December 29, 2024, Sylvia García Núñez (73), passed away suddenly to her eternal resting place. Sylvia was born on May 27, 1951, in the small town of Beeville, Texas, to her beloved mother, Esperanza (Hope) Martínez, and her father, Ysidro García. She was raised by her grandparents, Pedro and María Jasso. She was a resident of Kenner, Louisiana for 34 years.

Across the street from the gas station, there was a school for colored students. Some of the students would come to the gas station to purchase a few snacks. Her grandfather taught her compassion to serve those, no matter the color of their skin, in which she kept that quality throughout her life to help anyone in need.

Sylvia was a woman of many talents and passions. In her earlier years, she attended A.C. Jones High School and went on to learn secretarial studies at the College of San Antonio in Texas. Her jobs consisted of assistance at the San Antonio newspaper, a secretary at Bledsoe's Furniture Store, and a secretary at Century law office. Sylvia worked there until she met, married, and moved with her beloved husband, Edmundo Núñez. Then, she started her life as a military spouse. The military moved them from Texas to Georgia, Colorado, Oklahoma, and Louisiana. She held the fort down, when Ed would

leave for training. She also took care of the logistics of things for moving with kids and pets and kept so many things as organized as possible.

In her free time, she enjoyed wood crafting. She'd see something she liked in the store and told herself she could make it. She was a strong, loving, Catholic woman who said many prayers throughout her life for family & friends. She loved dancing with her children when they were younger. She enjoyed celebrating Birthdays and Christmases with the family, loved spending time with her sweet grandchildren, Keegan & Kaden, and crafting them something special, and loved watching football and soap operas with Ed.

Most of all, Sylvia made raising her children her priority and spent quality time with her adored family. Sylvia, along with Ed, raised three beautiful children until they left home. After they left, she stayed as present as she could along their life. Sylvia also babysat many children from time to time and helped mothers in need. She was a second mother to many.

As an empty-nester, Sylvia rejoined the workforce and dedicated 15 years to Wal-Mart Neighborhood Market. With her great work ethics and her care and want to help others, she was a great employee and gave co-workers any help as needed. She also met many who became her close friends.

Sylvia's impact on those around her was profound. Her selflessness, kindness, patience, giving nature, and unwavering love and care for others made her truly special.
