Terry Paul Landry (Pappy), age 63, of Harvey, Louisiana passed away on April 03, 2017. He was born on December 15, 1953 in Thibodaux, Louisiana. He graduated from East Jefferson High School (class of 72) and attending Delgado. Terry was a member of Delta Alpha Kappa fraternity, and had recently reconnected with some of his brothers. Terry worked at T.L. James Construction, where he surveyed the new runways at the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport.
