



Dr. Thomas Francis McCoy III

July 24, 1954 - March 16, 2023

Dr. Thomas F. McCoy, III , aged 68, passed away on March 16, 2023 after a courageous, well-fought battle with esophageal cancer. He is preceded in death by his father, Thomas McCoy, Jr. He is survived by his beloved wife Vicki Ross McCoy, his stepchildren Sean Ross Jensen (Catherine) and Hayley Samantha Jensen, his grandchildren Caleb Grant Jensen and Nora Kate Jensen, his mother Rosemary Latuso McCoy and his siblings Darlene McCoy Stokan (Joe) and Michael James McCoy (Teri). Tom was born on July 24, 1954 and was a lifetime resident of Kenner, Louisiana. He graduated from Archbishop Rummel High School with honors in 1972 and from the University of New Orleans with honors, obtaining a B.S. in biology in 1976. Tom was president of Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity at UNO. He graduated from Louisiana State University School of Dentistry in 1981 and practiced dentistry in Metairie, Louisiana for 40 years, retiring in April 2021. Tom was a past president of the New Orleans Chapter of the American Dental Association and was a parishioner of Divine Mercy Catholic Church.

Anyone who knew Tom well was aware he was a person of action, a man of his word, loyal and generous to a fault. He was a man you could count on if you needed his help and he could fix anything. Tom was an avid LSU fan. He also loved woodworking, gardening, cooking and spending time with his family and friends.
