Thomas "Tommy" Pritchett, Jr. passed away peacefully at his residence in the presence of his wife after a courageous battle with cancer. He was 60 years old, a native of New Orleans and resident of Kenner. He was born June 28, 1954 to the late Thomas M. Pritchett, Sr. and Jacqueline Kennair Pritchett. Tommy served his country as a Military Police Officer in the U. S. Army stationed in Germany; on returning home he joined the City of Kenner Police Department as an officer; then proudly served as a Narcotics Agent for the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office; he was a Special Agent with the U. S. Customs Service retiring after 20 years; most recently he was a civilian employee as Director of Property Management for the City of Kenner Police Department.

Tommy was predeceased by his parents. Mourning his loss is his beloved wife, Corinne Summers Pritchett. Tommy was the loving father of Teri "Mikki" Pritchett. Survivors include his siblings, David Pritchett (Rhonda); Karen LaBurre (Ronney), Jimmy Pritchett (brother and best friend); and Tiffany DeJean (Sid). He is also survived by many nephews and nieces who will miss their Uncle Tommy very much.
